Sustainability Guidelines for Decision Making

- **What we take:** We will continually reduce and eliminate our dependence on mined metals, minerals and fossil fuels - extract less, reuse, recycle and use renewable resources
- **What we make:** continually reduce and eliminate our use of manufactured non degradable chemicals and substances and use natural alternatives and recyclable materials
- **What we destroy:** Continually reduce and eliminate our dependence on activities that cause physical encroachment on the natural environment and draw resources from sustainably managed ecosystems, restore nature and protect biodiversity.
- **How we share:** Ensure that people everywhere are treated fairly and with respect to enable them to meet their needs efficiently – look after people and share resources fairly.
