2008 PINOT NOIR

Region	Marlborough
Vineyards	Johnson Estate, Outpost
Variety	100% Pinot Noir
Harvest Date	18 March to 6 April 2008
Brix at Harvest	23-25 °Brix
Viticulturist	Adam McCone
Soils	Shallow and stony soils with overlying sandy loam. Gravel and clay under loess on hillside slopes.
Winemakers	Paul Bourgeois, Brie Hughes and Kathy-Lee Bird
Winemaking	Seven separate blocks from our own vineyards were hand picked and fermented in 5 and 3 tonne open vats. Fermentation started naturally with 'wild' yeasts, after which the wine was pressed off the skins and aged in oak barrels for 10 months.
Colour	Medium Ruby
Bouquet	A potpourri of blueberry and violets with a typical Spy Valley layer of red fruit and liquorice.
Palate	Fruit sweetness dominates a rich and complex palate. The structure is classically firm while remaining supple and approachable.
Analysis	Residual Sugar <2.0 g/L pH 3.50 TA 5.9g/L Alcohol 14.0 % v/v

Cellaring	3-5 years



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
