Soils	Shallow and stony soils with overlying sandy loam.
Winemakers	Paul Bourgeois and Kathy-Lee Bird
Winemaking	After picking and slowly pressing the individual parcels were fermented with a portion in old oak vessels. After a long, slow fermentation the wines were aged for several months prior to blending and bottling.
Colour	Straw
Bouquet	A ripe flavour spectrum of ginger, coriander and white pepper. Tropical fruit and musk are evident.
Palate	A medley of spices and citrus fruits. The mouthfeel is defined by fruit sweetness and is delicately balanced with a taut structure to leave a satisfying finish.
Analysis	Residual Sugar 13.9 g/L pH 3.56 TA 5.4 g/l Alcohol 13.5 % v/v
